Isaiah 55:8-9

For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways, says the LORD.
For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.



There are so many ways that we can think of and try to understand what "God" is like. Each of us individually have our own images and ideas and metaphors. This is a good thing, as those things are all ways that help us to come to grips with "God". In reality, all of those things are simply words and images in our minds…not the actual being of "God". They can help us, but they can only take us so far…

What is often arrived at in our minds is that we cannot actually fathom what "God" really is...that we are left with simply...mystery and awe.

Mystery and awe of how vast and amazing and good and gracious "God" is...and that this being deigns to dwell with us...to be with us...here...

It's amazing and humbling and well...mysterious!

For quite a few years I have listened to a Lutheran Duo called "Lost and Found." They have a song called "Here", and it lifts up many of the words and images that we think of, when we think of God. The song does so with paradoxes of words and how God is those things and also more than them.

I commend it to you as the song leaves us with those images but also with the truth that the mysterious love of God for each of us "drives out fear."

Ministry Site Profile (MSP) / Call Committee Update – March 2024

The Ministry Site Profile (MSP) / Call Committee team has been meeting regularly (about twice per month) since November 2023 and are making consistent progress toward the calling of an associate pastor.

The Ministry Site Profile (MSP) / Call Committee team is a diverse group of dedicated members, including Cathy Jarosinski, Fred Stieg, Loren Fuglestad, Joel Gregozeski, Kelly Hohman, Kiley Mroczynski, and Pastor Stuart. The team is being consulted by Cathy Cowling and Pastor Asher from the ELCA.

The Ministry Site Profile (MSP) / Call Committee's effort comes after the Church Council held several congregational listening sessions in 2023. The Council hired an outside consultant (Cathy Cowling) to facilitate the listening sessions and to complete two Council retreats where the Council thoughtfully and methodically reflected on staffing needs, roles, and responsibilities. Following the listening sessions and retreats, the Council approved the senior pastor and associate pastor roles, along with specific responsibilities for each position.

The committee has completed the draft Ministry Site Profile (MSP) and has submitted it for review and approval by the Church Council. Once approved, the Ministry Site Profile (MSP) can be shared with the congregation and will be submitted to the Synod; and the position becomes posted for potential candidates.

Presently, the Ministry Site Profile (MSP) / Call Committee is in the process of developing interview questions and will look to complete a mock interview soon.

After posting the MSP, the call process begins. The Synod Director for Transitions will then provide candidates to the Ministry Site Profile (MSP) / Call Committee to review. Selected candidates will go through a substantial discernment process. Please note, the Committee

will keep candidate information confidential during the discernment process. Once a candidate of choice is identified for approval, information will be shared regarding the candidate of choice for congregation approval.

To follow the process along the many steps, check out our progression chart of the MSP/Call Committee in the "Gathering Area," made by Kelly Hohman.




