Pastor's Page

Genesis 3:9

But the Lord God called out to the man, "Where are you?"



Have you ever thought about where you are "spiritually"? I mean, about where you think and feel that you are in relation to your relationship with God? It might seem like a strange thing to ask to some of you, and to others it may seem like it's a no-brainer. But it IS a good question to ask yourself.

Where am I with God? How do I feel about God? What kinds of experiences or events in my life have either lead me toward or away from faith or trust in God? What people around me either challenge me or lead me away from a closer understanding and closer experience with God?

Where are you?

It's a very good thing to take stock of this kind of thing, this aspect of your life, because, let's face it, if you don't stop and take the time, you'll never have a good awareness of where you are.

Everyone has faith, it's just a matter of where or who your put your faith in. We all have moments of joy and sorrow, fun and pain, grace and law, but at the end of the day who do you trust to hold you up through all things in life?

The faith aspect of all of our lives is a process, and it's lifelong.

One of my absolute favorite authors, Donald Miller starts out one of his books, "Blue Like Jazz," in this way:

"I once listened to an Indian on television say that God was in the wind and the water, and I wondered at how beautiful that was because it meant you could swim in Him or have Him brush your face in a breeze. I am early in my story, but I believe I will stretch into eternity, and in heaven I will reflect upon these early days, these days when it seemed God was down a dirt road, walking towards me. Years ago He was a swinging speck in the distance; now He is close enough I can hear His singing. Soon I will see the lines on His face."

I just love how he describes this aspect of our lives, the faith part. Each day, each moment is an opportunity to grow closer to God. We all have these endless opportunities for goodness, truth, love, care, compassion, giving, forgiving, mercy, peace and hope. Times when we can live in the moment, feeling the wind in our face or the water on our skin and realize that there is something out there that is calling to us in love.

We all have these possibilities in our lives. True, life is also full of hard things and pain and difficulties, but it's also in those times that we can reach out to God and God will answer. God will give strength, hope and love.

So...where are you? Where are you in your awareness of God and God's grace for you, wherever you are in life?

I hope that you would take some time to better understand where you are. Because wherever you are, God is there with you...in love and in mercy and in strength and in hope.

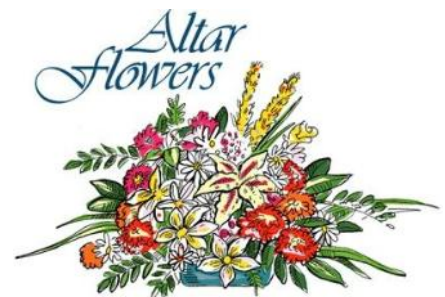

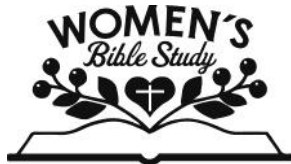
PATHWAYS TO PEACE
