Sponsorship can be in memory or honor of someone, for a birthday, special event and more. Flowers are displayed for the Sunday worship services and can be taken home after the 10:30 worship service. The cost is \$30. Sign up for flowers can be done in the hallway at church, in the office, or online. The deadline to sign up for flowers is noon on the Wednesday before a given Sunday.

If a family is interested in sending their child(ren) to a church camp and would like some financial support, there is a form in the church office. Peace may grant ½ the cost of the camp up to \$250 – the check will be made out directly to the camp, not an individual.

Peace Volunteer Hours

Peace can keep track of high schoolers' volunteer work hours done at/for Peace.

- Hours will be tracked using this QR code until the end of Semester 1 of a student's senior year.



This data can be used for the Peace Scholarship application, for the Peace graduation service, and any other personal use (i.e. college and scholarship application) logging volunteer/community service hours.

At the Peace graduation service, students will be recognized who have contributed:

- ✝ ≥ 20 hours - students will receive a certificate
- ✝ ≥ 40 hours - students will also receive a graduation cord*

* it is the family's responsibility to see if the cord can be worn at the student's graduation ceremony at their high school

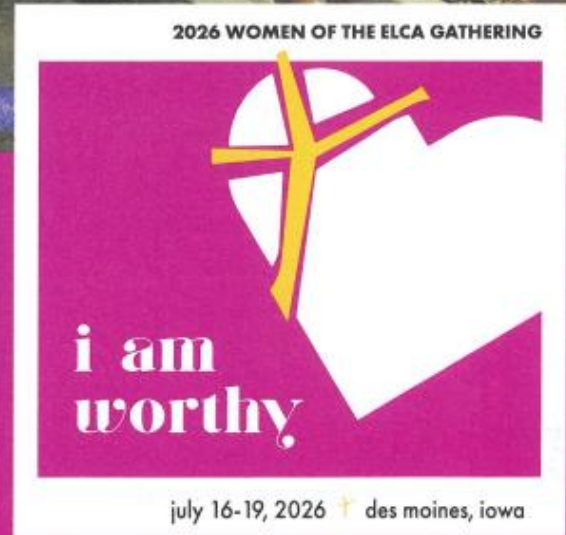
